

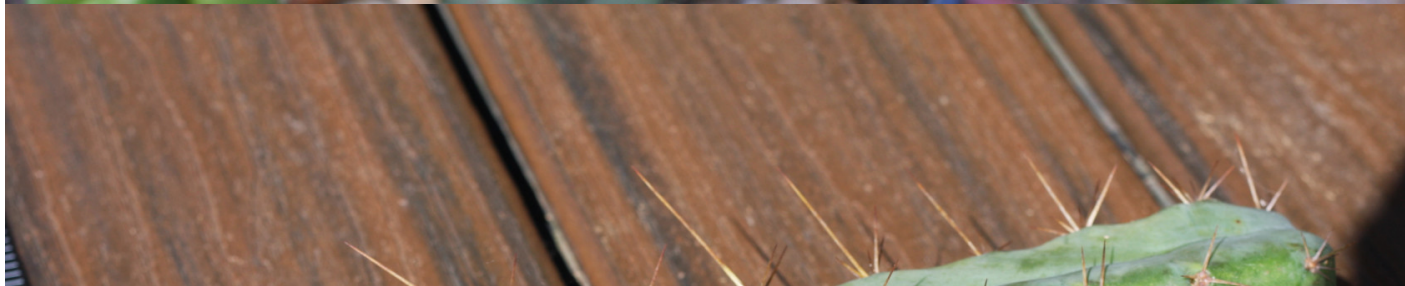

Zelly (Scopulicola x Variegated Red Grandiflora)

"Zelly....." Scop x VRG (Scopulicola x Variegated Red Grandiflora)



This beautiful plant with a deep green look when grown in shade. with tightly dense spines and beautiful flowers with a wide range of colors. There are many different "Zelly" Scop x VRG with a variety of characteristics. Some sown seeds show variegation. The one above has none. It was one of the first to come out back in around 2015 (rough guess.) Crossed and named by [Misplant.net](https://misplant.net)

Can be variegated all the way to “banana” with no or almost no green.
